This Privacy Policy describes how Vesta Legacy Partners (“Vesta,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) collects, uses, and shares information through **www.vestalp.com** (the “Site”). This policy applies only to information collected through the Site. By using the Site, you accept the practices described below. If you do not agree, please discontinue use of the Site.

2. Information We Collect**2.1 Information You Provide**

We collect information you submit through the Site, including when you subscribe to communications, complete an inquiry or contact form, request materials, or otherwise correspond with us. This information may include your name, email address, telephone number, employer or affiliations, investor profile, and the content of any messages you send.

2.2 Information Collected Automatically

When you visit the Site, we and our service providers and advertising partners automatically collect technical and usage information through cookies, pixels, tags, and similar technologies. We may combine information collected through the Site with information obtained from other sources, and we may retain and use de-identified or aggregated information for any purpose.

4. How We Share Information

We may share information with the following categories of recipients:

- Affiliates and related entities under common ownership or control.
- Service providers and vendors that support our operations, including hosting, email and CRM platforms (such as CapitallystPro), and other technology providers.
- Analytics and advertising partners, including providers such as Google Analytics and operators of advertising and social media platforms.
- Professional advisors, including legal, accounting, compliance, tax, and consulting professionals.
- Parties to actual or potential transactions, including in connection with financings, joint ventures, mergers, acquisitions, reorganizations, or sales of assets.
- Government authorities and other parties when we believe disclosure is required by law, regulation, legal process, or government request, or appropriate to enforce our terms, protect our rights, property, or safety, or those of others.

5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

The Site uses cookies, pixels, tags, software development kits, and similar technologies for purposes including site functionality, authentication, preference storage, analytics, personalization, and advertising. These technologies are operated by us and by third parties, including Google Analytics and similar providers. You may control or disable cookies through your browser or device settings; doing so may affect Site functionality.

6. Targeted Advertising and Opt-Out Choices

We participate in targeted advertising. This may involve sharing identifiers, online activity, and inferred interests with advertising partners and platforms to deliver and measure advertising across other websites and services. Depending on your jurisdiction, this activity may be treated as a “sale” or “share” of personal information under applicable law.

7. Your Rights
